

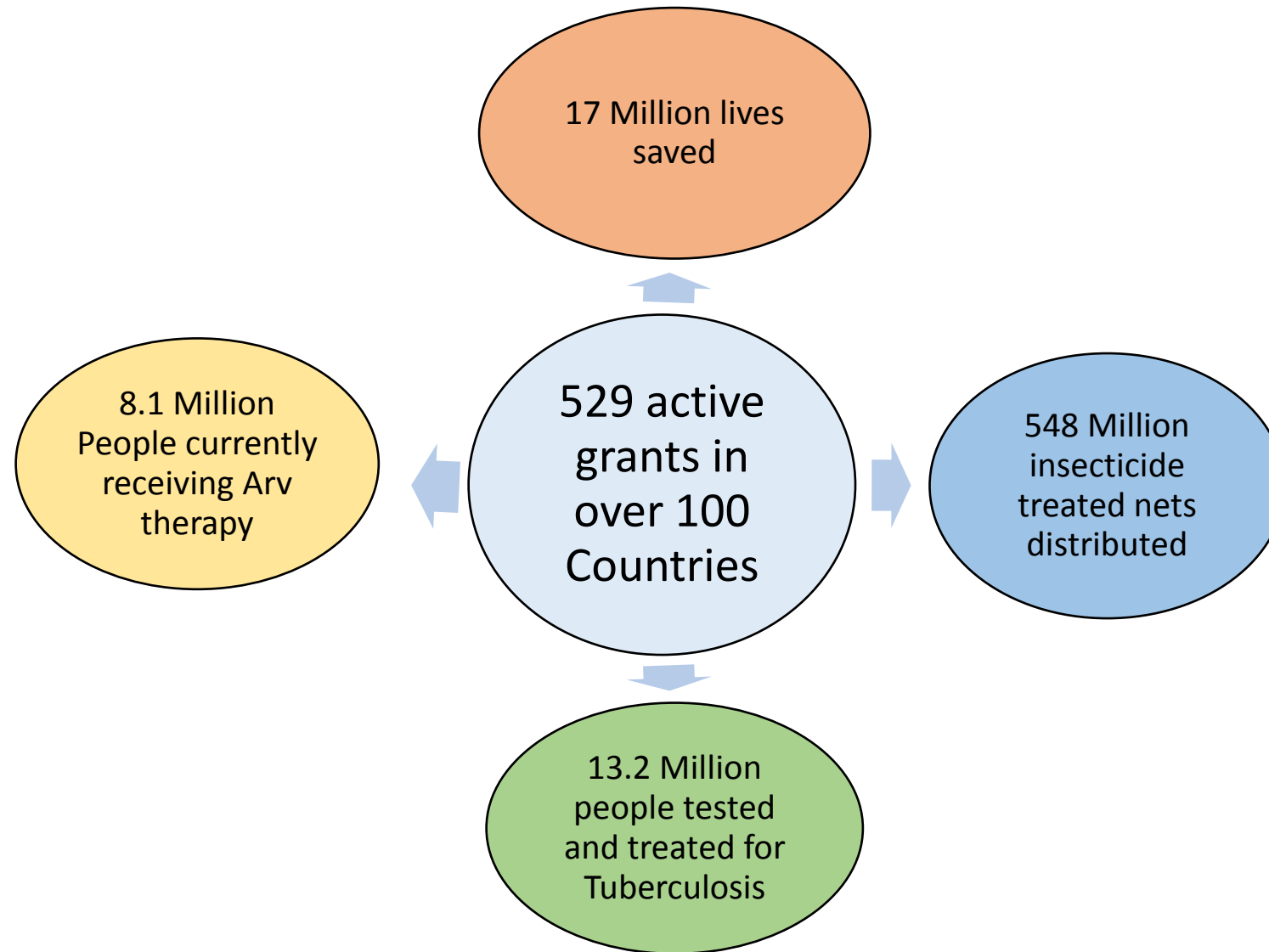

The Global Fund

- Global Fund is a partnership organization founded in 2002, designed to accelerate the end of AIDS, tuberculosis and malaria as epidemics worldwide
- It aims to attract and disburse additional resources to prevent and treat HIV/AIDS, TB, Malaria
- World's largest financier for anti HIV/AIDS, TB, Malaria programs
- Have made cumulative and fully paid contributions of more than US\$33 billion by 2015

Global Fund Portfolio in India

- Has a strong and sustained partnership with India since 2003, with US \$1.6 billion grant committed so far and US \$ 1.59 billion disbursed.
- India is the second largest recipient of Global Fund Grant after Nigeria.
- India under the New Funding Model is eligible to receive US \$905 million for implementation period, 1st Oct, 2015- 31st Dec,2017
- Framework Agreement and Grant confirmation for the implementation period 2015-2017 have been signed

Malaria: Insecticide-treated nets distributed
