(Whole Blood Finger Prick Test, Virtual Intervention)

Prison Intervention

Robust communication intervention to cater to the emergent needs - promote safe sex and reduce discrimination against HIV and STI- focus on youth & adolescent

Evaluation of TI & LWS

Priority Areas – Testing and Treatment

Focus on Hard to reach areas and On-site Mobile service delivery

Bridging linkage losses at all levels for general population and pregnant women, prison and OCS inmates

Focus on MIS and LFU client; Strengthen adherence and reducing mortality

Dual testing for HIV & Syphilis

Strengthening of Cold chain
(Ice Line Refrigerators and Strengthening of CMSS warehouses)

Single window service delivery in community setting
(One Stop Center)

Strengthening Lab Components for quality assessments for STIs and OIs (Advanced HIV Disease)

Engagement with private sector for HIV & Syphilis testing of pregnant women and linkage of positive pregnant women

Integration with NTEP, NVHCP, NHM

Scale up of Viral Load Testing
(Viral Load testing at public VL Labs)

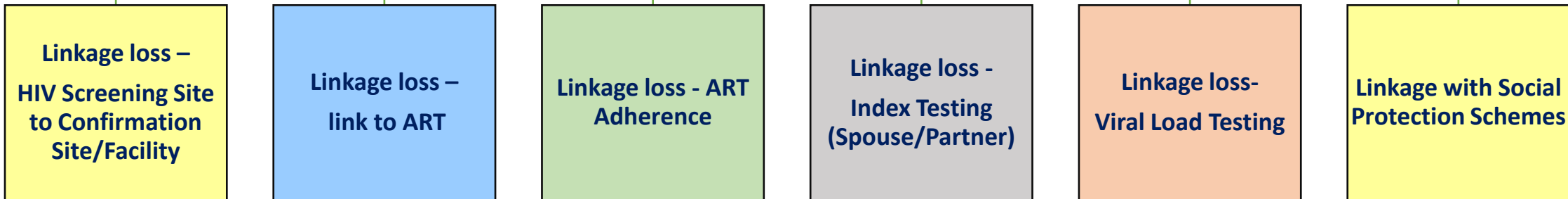

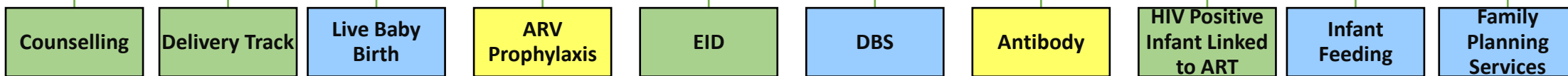

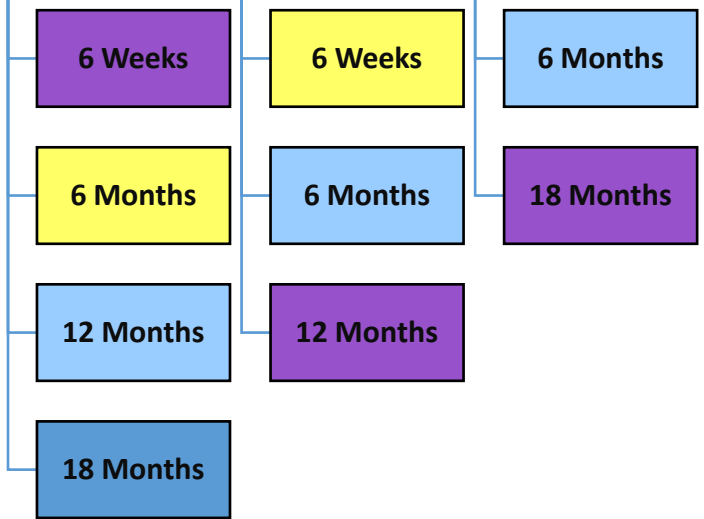
